The Flight Technologies and Procedures Division has reviewed the report of the Potomac Aviation Technology Corp. (PATC) integration of the Belfort Instruments 6230A Visibility Sensor into the Superunicom system. The results of this report indicate that this integration provides for an effective transmission of visibility data over the existing Superunicom platform.

Accordingly, the Superunicom system, incorporating a Belfort Instruments 6230A Visibility Sensor (by the architecture described in the PATC report dated August 16, 2001) has been determined to be an approved source of visibility information for flight operations.
